- "I am" Poem** - Student volunteers write a short poem where each line begins with "I am". The poem helps students express themselves as individuals by describing in their own words who they are and what's important to their identity. Deadline for poems is December 21. Template will be sent to interested families. Poems will be displayed during Children's Diversity Night.
- Closing Procession** – Student volunteers dress in their ethnic clothing and participate in a short procession at the end of the Children's Diversity Night. All student volunteers will be grouped by country and will walk together in the procession. All students will say "thank you" and "farewell" in their native language.
- Group Dance** – Four groups of student volunteers will be randomly selected to perform short (3-4 minute) dances reflective of their heritage and/or background. **Please provide information about the dance group on the back of this form.
