On opening night of the 2016 season, the Crowley High School football program will recognize one of the greatest players to ever wear the purple and white.

Gary Reasons was a standout multi-sport athlete for the Eagles, earning 13 varsity letters from 1976-80. He was an all-region linebacker and First Team All-State tight end as a senior.

He earned a scholarship to play linebacker at Northwestern State University in Louisiana, where he was the first three-time All American in Division 1-AA (FCS) history. In 1996, he was among the inaugural class of small school college players inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame.

His nine-year NFL career included highlights such as:

- Selected to the NFL All Rookie Team in 1984
- Selected to the All Madden and All NFL Teams in 1989
- Member of the New York Giants teams that won victories in Super Bowls XXI and XXV
