#### Parents,

Attention: Tooele County School District has moved to electronic flyers. Very few flyers will be mailed or sent home with your student. Please read the following information to ensure you receive all information, being sent electronically from your school, regarding your student, such as, newsletters, etc.

Tooele County School District is beginning to use an electronic flyer (e-flyers) distribution program called Peachjar. Peachjar replaces paper flyers. Each school can send e-flyers to students/parents through your email. These e-flyers are also posted on each school's website for at least one month. Look for the the Peachjar link in your school's website.

If you provided your email address on your student's contact information during registration, a Peachjar account has been established for you. You should receive an email from Peachjar with your login information. This is provided so that you can manage your account and flyer delivery preferences. You do not need to log in to receive or view e-flyers. If you did not provide your email address and would like to receive Peachjar e-flyers, you can log into Aspire on tooeleschools.org and update your contact information with your email address. If you need assistance, you are encouraged to contact your school's secretary, 833-1921.

To prevent the e-flyers from going into your spam folder, add <a href="mailto:tooeleschools@peachjar.com">to your emailtooeleschools@peachjar.com</a> to your email contacts. When you receive your first e-flyer, be sure to click "always display images."

Peachjar is used exclusively for distribution of school-approved flyers. Your email address will not be shared or used for any other purpose.

If you do not have email, you can access e-flyers and other information by logging into tooeleschools.org and going to your school's website.



#### Please note:

#### **SCHOOL EMERGENCIES**

When a school emergency or disaster situation occurs, we want to be prepared. A school emergency response chart is posted in every classroom with directions for emergencies that may occur while school is in session. Students will review these procedures with the teacher during the first week of school. See the student handbook for more details. In case of major emergencies, parents can help us by not calling the school. The best way to gain information is by turning on radios or televisions to hear important broadcasted information.

#### **Relocation Centers:**

If we need to relocate away from Tooele Jr. High because of an emergency, we will move to the Tooele High auditorium or to the LDS church on Coleman Street. If necessary, we could relocate to the Deseret Peak Complex. You will be able to pick up your student there. Students will only be released to parents or persons identified on the student's emergency release form.

#### **Serving on the Community Council**

Serving on our School Community Council is a wonderful way for parents and teachers to contribute and help improve academic performance at our school. The council reviews and prepares academic plans for our students each year. All plans are reviewed for final approval by our school board. Councils also act in an advisory capacity to school and school district administrations.

#### Qualifications

Every public school in Utah has a School Community Council. The councils are made up of school employees who are elected by employees and parents who are elected by parents of students attending the school. Membership terms are for two years. Elections are held at the beginning of each school year. Parent members must have a student attending the school at least one of the two years of their term of service.
